




















Arborvitae, Nigra

(Potted)

-  Type: Evergreen, Conifer
-  Height: 40 - 60'
-  Spread: 6 - 8'
-  Form: Pyramidal
-  Growth Rate: Medium - Fast
-  Life Expectancy: Long
-  USDA Zone: 4 - 8
-  Root Pattern: Shallow
-  Sun: Full to Partial Shade
-  Soil Texture: Sand & Loam Soils, Widely Adaptable
-  Topography: Low, Damp or Mesic Conditions
-  Plant Community: Landscapes, Windbreak
-  Origin: North America
-  Needle: Pliable, fan-like, on main shoots, $\frac{1}{4}$ " long with long points, lateral shoots are flattened, $\frac{1}{8}$ " long with short points
-  Dense, dark green version of "White Cedar"
-  Excellent hedge or natural fence for privacy
-  Quite Hardy
-  Insect and disease resistant
-  Holds its dark green foliage color throughout winter
