

















# Cedar, White

(Transplant)

-  Type: Evergreen, Conifer
-  Height: 40-50'
-  Spread: 20 - 50'
-  Form: Conical
-  Growth Rate: Medium
-  Life Expectancy: Long
-  USDA Zone: 2 - 8
-  Sun: Full to Partial
-  Soil Texture: Sandy Loam to Clay
-  Topography: Upland, Lowland (Stable Water), Wetland
-  Plant Community: Forest, Bog
-  Origin: MSA Zone 1, 2, 3, 4, MN, N. America
-  Needle: Pliable, fan-like, on main shoots,  $\frac{1}{4}$ " long with long points, lateral shoots are flattened,  $\frac{1}{8}$ " long with short points
-  "Arborvitae"
-  Useful for windbreaks & wildlife habitat
-  Not recommended for roadsides unless in protected locations & where deer population is low
