

# Dolgo Crabapple

(Pollinators)

-  Type: Standard, Deciduous
-  Height: 35 - 40'
-  Spread: 25 - 30', Wide-Spreading
-  Growth Rate: Vigorous
-  Life Expectancy: 20 - 30 years
-  USDA Zone: 2 - 7, Very Cold Hardy
-  Sun: Full
-  Soil: Variety, Well-Drained, Slightly Acidic
-  Origin: 1897 Russian Imported to South Dakota
  - Open-pollinated Siberian crab
-  Bloom Period: Mid-May, Very Fragrant
-  Blooms: Pink opening to a pink tinged white, single, 2"
-  Harvest: Mid - Late August
-  Fruit Size: 1.5", Large
-  Fruit Color: Normally Red (ranges from crimson to deep purple)
-  Flavor: Moderately juicy, medium textured, rich but tart
-  Edible: Yes
-  Use: Jellies and sauces with fine flavor and color
-  Shelf Life: Short
-  Pollinator Required: Yes
-  Attracts Butterflies and Birds
-  Good or better disease resistance to the four major Crabapple Diseases: Scab, Fireblight, Cedar Apple Rust & Frog Eye Leaf Spot
