(Short Tree & Flowering Crab)

-  Type: Deciduous Tree
-  Height: 15 - 20'
-  Spread: 20 - 20'
-  Form: Open, Upright, Spreading
-  Growth Rate: Moderate - Fast
-  Life Expectancy: Medium
-  USDA Zone: 3 - 8, Very Hardy, Stays on in the Winter
-  Root Pattern: Shallow Lateral
-  Sun: Full Sun
-  Blooms: Range from white to dark pink, single
-  Soil Texture: Sandy Loam to Clay Loam
-  Topography: Upland
-  Plant Community: Forest Edge
-  Origin: Fertile, MN
-  Fruit Size:  $\frac{1}{2}$ "
-  Fruit Color: Red
-  Edible: No (not for human consumption)
-  Use: Excellent food for wildlife
-  Attracts Butterflies and Birds
-  Litter free
-  Slightly susceptible to scab, moderate to fireblight
