-  Height: 18 - 20'
-  Spread: 20', Upright, Rounded
-  Growth Rate: Medium; Disease Resistant
-  Life Expectancy: 20 - 30 years
-  USDA Zone: 3 - 7, Drought Tolerant, Hardy
-  Sun: Full
-  Soil: Sandy Loam to Clay Loam; Well Drained
-  Origin: Introduced by Sutherland Experiment Station, Saskatoon, Saskatchewan
-  Bloom Period: Spring, Fragrant
-  Blooms: Deep Red / Purple; One of the best foliage form
-  Harvest: Fall
-  Fruit Size: $\frac{3}{4}$ " , Purple-Red
-  Fruit Color: Bright Red over Orange
-  Flavor: Excellent
-  Edible: Yes
-  Use: Fresh eating, apple butter or spiced apples
-  Shelf Life: Long
-  Pollinator Required: No, Self-Fruitful, however, more abundant yield if planted w/another variety
-  Fall Color: The leaves have a bright, varnished appearance and a nice purple fall color
-  New growth is reddish to purplish w/green undercast
-  Attracts Butterflies and Birds
