(Tall Tree)

-  Type: Deciduous Tree
-  Height: 60 - 80'
-  Spread: 40 - 50'
-  Form: Rounded
-  Growth Rate: Fast
-  Life Expectancy: Medium
-  USDA Zone: 3 - 7
-  Root Pattern: Shallow Lateral
-  Sun: Full to Partial
-  Soil Texture: Sandy Loam to Silty Clay, Wide range of soil tolerant
-  Topography: Upland, Lowland (Flood Prone/Stable Water), Wetland
-  Plant Community: Forest, Savannah
-  Origin: MSA Zone 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, MN, N. America
-  Silver / green foliage turns yellow in fall
-  Plant in parks or large areas due to large mature height
-  Bark becomes flaky with age
