(Tall Tree)

-  Type: Deciduous Tree
-  Height: 50 - 70'
-  Spread: 20 - 50'
-  Form: Pyramidal / Symmetrical
-  Growth Rate: Medium
-  Life Expectancy: Medium
-  USDA Zone: 4 - 8
-  Root Pattern: Shallow Lateral
-  Sun: Full
-  Soil Texture: Sandy Loam to Clay, Prefers Moist, Well-Drained Soils
-  Topography: Upland, Lowland (Flood Prone/Stable Water)
-  Plant Community: Forest
-  Origin: North America
-  Fall Color: foliage varies from red-orange to russet
-  Widely planted oak
-  Transplants easier than most oaks
-  Somewhat tolerant of city conditions
