-  Type: Evergreen, Conifer
-  Height: 75 - 100'
-  Spread: 50 - 75'
-  Form: Conical
-  Growth Rate: Medium - Fast
-  Life Expectancy: Long
-  USDA Zone: 3 - 5
-  Root Pattern: Deep Lateral
-  Sun: Full to Partial
-  Soil Texture: Sandy Loam to Silty Clay
-  Topography: Upland
-  Plant Community: Forest
-  Origin: MSA Zone 1, 2, 3, MN, N. America, Non-North America
-  Needle: Stiff needles, 4 - 6" long, with two needles per fascicle that snap cleanly when bend, dark green
-  Valuable for pulpwood & timber
-  Great for windbreaks
