(Seedling, Transplant & Potted)

-  Height: 75 - 100'
-  Type: Evergreen Tree
-  Spread: 50 - 75'
-  Form: Conical
-  Growth Rate: Fast
-  Life Expectancy: Long
-  USDA Zone: 2 - 7
-  Root Pattern: Shallow Lateral
-  Sun: Full Sun, Partial Sun, Shade Tolerant
-  Soil Texture: Loamy Sand to Clay Loam
-  Topography: Upland
-  Plant Community: Forest
-  Origin: MSA Zone 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, MN, N. America
-  Needle: Soft, 3 - 5" long, with five slender, flexible needles per fascicle, needles appear blue/green because of 3 or more glaucous lines of stomata
-  Useful in windbreaks, wildlife & Christmas trees
-  Mature trees exhibit horizontal branching
