(Seedling)

-  Type: Evergreen, Conifer
-  Height: 30 - 60'
-  Spread: 15 - 25'
-  Form: Conical
-  Growth Rate: Slow
-  Life Expectancy: Medium
-  USDA Zone: 2 - 6
-  Root Pattern: Shallow Lateral
-  Sun: Full to Partial
-  Soil Texture: Sand to Clay, Grows well in organic soils
-  Topography: Upland, Lowland (Stable Water), Wetland
-  Plant Community: Forest, Bog, Marsh
-  Origin: MSA Zone 1, 2, 3, 4, MN, N. America
-  Needle: Four-sided, stiff, $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ " long, light blue/green, somewhat blunt pointed tips, light blue/green to gray
-  Native to swamps, grows rapidly on well-drained and moist bottomlands
