




















Spruce, Colorado

(Transplant & Potted)

-  Type: Evergreen, Conifer
-  Height: 80'
-  Spread: 20 - 35'
-  Form: Conical
-  Growth Rate: Medium
-  Life Expectancy: Long
-  USDA Zone: 3 - 7
-  Root Pattern: Shallow Lateral
-  Sun: Full to Partial
-  Soil Texture: Sandy Loam to Clay
-  Topography: Upland, Thrives in Moist or Dry Soils
-  Plant Community: Forest
-  Origin: North America
-  Needle: Stiff & very sharp (spine-like), $\frac{3}{4}$ - $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " long, displayed nearly straight out from twig, silvery-blue to dark green
-  The most adaptable spruce
-  Not native to MN
-  Used for windbreaks and Christmas trees
-  Also referred to as the 'Blue Spruce'
-  Blue foliage is lost when planted in the shade
