

















Spruce, White

(Seedling, Transplant & Potted)

-  Type: Evergreen, Conifer
-  Height: 75 - 100'
-  Spread: 20'
-  Form: Upright Pyramidal
-  Growth Rate: Fast
-  Life Expectancy: Long
-  USDA Zone: 2 - 6
-  Root Pattern: Shallow
-  Sun: Full to Partial
-  Soil Texture: Moist, Acidic, Loamy Soils
-  Topography: Very Adaptable, Stream Banks, Lake Shores and Adjacent Slopes
-  Plant Community: Forest
-  Origin: MN, N. America
-  Needle: Stiff, $1/3 - \frac{3}{4}$ " long, square in cross section, needle tips are pointed but not sharp, when crushed a pungent odor is apparent (some say similar to cat urine), green to gray/green, each needle borne on a raised, woody peg (sterigma)
-  Withstands heat, cold & drought
-  Great for mass planting, wildlife, windbreaks, Christmas trees & pulpwood
