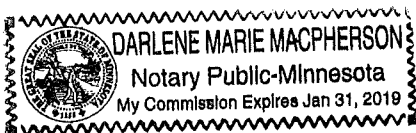

## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ENACT NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ADOPT THE COMPREHENSIVE LOCAL WATER PLAN

A Public Hearing will be held before the Morrison County Board for consideration of The Comprehensive Local Water Plan. The Comprehensive Local Water Plan is required to be updated every five years. This version, an update by requirement, is virtually a re-write in lieu of all of the changes occurring in water quality protection. The new plan is based on the five major watersheds in the county, and focuses on minor watershed initiatives. Comments received at the Public Hearing will accompany the plan as submitted to the state for final approval, following state agency review.

The hearing will be held at 9:00 a.m. on April 18, 2017 in the County Board Room of the Morrison County Government Center. Copies of the proposed plan will be available prior to the public hearing at the Land Services Department.
